

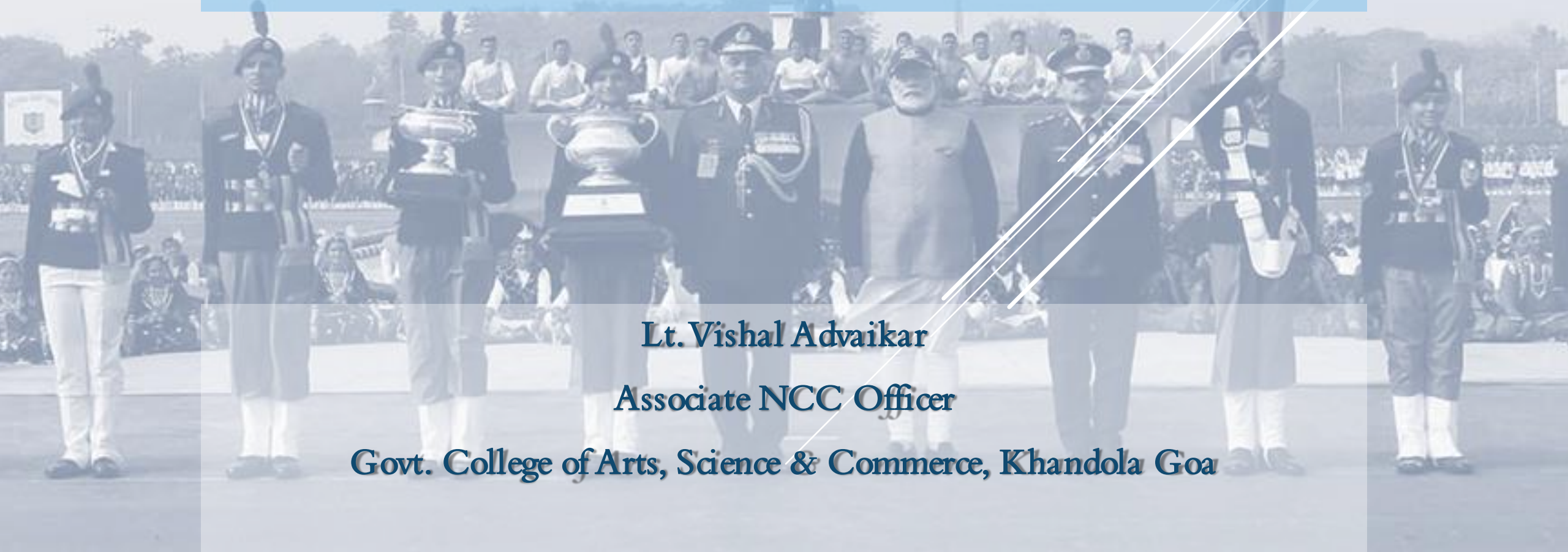

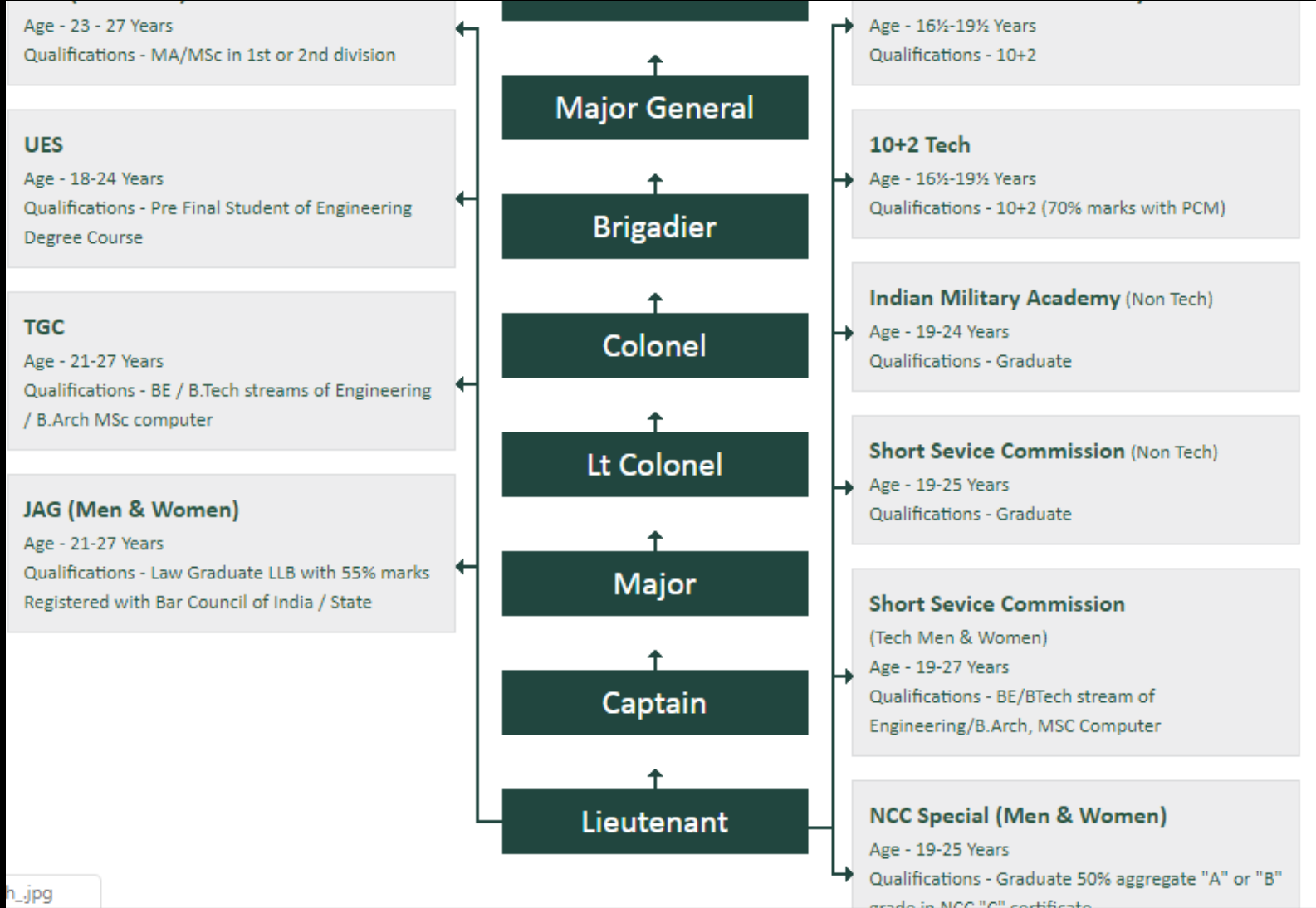

To develop qualities of character, courage, comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure and sportsmanship and the ideals of selfless service among the youth to make them useful citizen.



To create a human resource of organised trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all walks of life including the Armed Forces and be always available for the service of the nation.



It also aims at to create a pool of human youth to absorb into Indian armed forces like Army, Navy, Air force and other paramilitary forces.



Activities



Drill

Cadets must be made to understand the aim and purpose of teaching drill. It emphasizes on bearing, marching, saluting and arms drill.

Weapon Training

Cadets generally take interest in weapon and firing.





Activities and Training of NCC



The training is mostly carried out in schools and colleges by the cadets.

Drill, shooting, Physical fitness, map reading, First aid, Gliding/Flying, boat pulling, sailing and camp training covering basic of military training in Army, Navy and Air Force.

The objective of the training is to install discipline and personality development of the candidate.



Adventure Training

Adventure activities have been incorporated in NCC training with the aim of inculcating and strengthening leadership traits amongst the cadets. These activities in NCC can be broadly divided into the following.

1. **Land based** - Mountaineering, Rock Climbing, Trekking.
2. **Water based** - Sailing expedition, White Water Rafting, Scuba Diving, River Crossing.
3. **Air based** - Parasailing.



Ranks In NCC

- Cadets who join the NCC are also given ranks according to their merit and seniority.
- The ranks are similar in all the Divisions.
- The cadet rankings only extend up to the level of NCOs and they need not salute each other (except coming to attention when standing before a Senior).
- The ranked cadets are known as Cadet NCOs. The Junior Division and Junior Wing do not have ranks above Sergeant Major.
- The Sergeant Major of a troop is known as a Troop Sergeant.
During camps, ranks of Regimental Sergeant Major (RSM) and Regimental Quarter-Master Sergeant (RQMS) are used.
- Ranks in the NCC (Senior Division & Senior Wing);
- Senior Cadet Under Officer (one in a Company)
- Cadet Under Officer (three in a Company)
- Company Sergeant Major (one in a Company)
- Company Quarter Master Sergeant (one in a Company)
- Sergeant (three in a Company excluding the CSM and CQMS)
- Corporal (ten in a Company)

- **Central Reserve Police Force Benefits TO NCC Certificate Holders**
 - For joining as Officers (Company Commanders, Quartermasters and Dy SPs), the minimum prescribed qualification is a Second class Bachelors Degree. However, NCC 'B' OR 'C' Certificate holders having a Third Class Bachelors Degree are also considered eligible.
 - **Central Industrial Security Force Benefits TO NCC Certificate Holders**
 - Additional marks at the scale of 'one' mark for 'B' Certificate holders and 'Three' marks for 'C' Certificate holders are given to candidates in the rank of 'Constable'.
 - **Joining Coast Guard Benefits TO NCC Certificate Holders**
 - Additional weightage between 03 and 10 is given to candidates for joining in both Officer cadre as well as Enrolled personnel.
