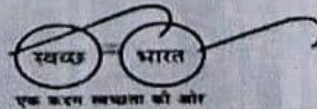


13. 'B' Certificate examination result
